<p>Clinical Outpatient Services: A wide range of comprehensive services are provided to children and adolescents by our licensed, professional clinical staff, including individual therapy and family counseling. These services include counseling for children and adolescents who experience emotional disturbance, disruptive behaviors, and substance abuse concerns. This program also offers 24-hour emergency on-call services to children and families.</p> <p>Psychological Services: Our professional psychological staff offers comprehensive services including clinical and psycho-educational testing by a state licensed psychologist.</p> <p>Psychiatric/Medical Services: HealthWays offers psychiatric evaluations, consultation, medication management and monitoring through our on-staff board-certified psychiatrist, nurses, and family physicians.</p> <p>Greentree Adolescent IOP: This program offers Intensive Outpatient Services to dually diagnosed adolescents ages 13-18. The services include individual counseling, family counseling, supportive counseling, case management, intensive treatment group (twice a week), supportive treatment group (1 time a week), and parent support group.</p> <p>Children’s Clinical Liaison Services: Child and Adolescent Clinical Liaison Services is a grant-funded support program for children and families struggling with mental concerns who are in need of support within their community. This Liaison acts as a consultant and referral source for community members and local agencies.</p> <p>School-Based Supportive Services: HealthWays offer a Community Engagement Specialist to the local school districts to provide supportive services to students who may experience emotional disturbance or challenging behaviors. This Community Engagement Specialist provides evidenced-based curriculums to identified students within the school which focus on many topics such as anxiety, effective communication, anger control, bullying, expressing feelings etc. We also provide evidenced-based prevention services in the classroom setting which also focus on social, emotional, and academic development.</p> <p>IDD Waiver Program: HealthWays provides a wide array of services for assessment, services planning, linkage, referral and advocacy for individuals with Intellectual and Developmental disabilities. This program includes the use of Behavior Support Professionals who provide adaptive skills training to individuals with IDD. This program is responsible for coordinating services of the IDD Waiver Program.</p>
