<p>Level I Stepping Stone, Inc. is a non-profit Level 1 residential treatment facility for adolescent males ages 12-17 and transitioning adult males ages 18-21. We treat youth with challenges including, but not limited to, abuse/neglect, truancy, academic difficulties, status and delinquent offenses.</p> <p>Our program is designed to teach our residents respect for themselves, for others, for community, and for the world. This is done through education and re-education. Education is the foundation of our program. Residents attend public school or work towards their TASC with the support of our staff.
