The Youth Accelerated Learning Environment (YALE) Academy has a service capacity for 24 children, serving males and females, who have been diagnosed with co-occurring issues. Children who have co-occurring issues are treated through cognitive-behavioral methods of behavioral change and learning to recognize and change the bio-psycho-social conditions that maintain a person's addictive behavior. This approach is designed to teach them coping skills which will help them remain substance free after discharge from the program. The YALE Academy serves children ages 12 to 17 and transitioning adults up to age 21. Academy Programs prides itself on its commitment to best serving children and families with the highest intensive treatment needs.

In congruence with the Re-Education philosophy, Academy Programs considers education to be a vital component to a child's treatment as it is essential to providing the child with his or her greatest chance at success in life as a child and as an adult. Academy Programs melds the academic and treatment process. Academic success is vital to a child's sense of self and well-being thus allowing the treatment process to succeed at a higher level.
