<p>Level II The Youth Achievement Center (YAC) is a Level II Residential Treatment Program for boys ages 12-17 diagnosed with a co-existing disorder, developmental/cognitive disability (IQ Score between 55-70) and mental health condition impacting functioning. Our program is based on a Positive Behavior Support model focusing on nurturing and building skills.
