Psychiatric Residential Treatment

Barboursville School is a Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility providing a safe environment that helps adolescents & their families through the difficult times of severe emotional disturbances. BVS is a secure 24-hour psychiatric facility for those that have failed in a less restrictive environment, it consists of 22 beds divided into three cottages; we serve both male and females from the ages of 12 through 18 who require intensive psychiatric residential treatment for an average length of stay of six to nine months. Barboursville School offers full-day, extended-year, education services staffed by a principal, school counselor and fully certified teachers, employed by the West Virginia Office of Diversion and Transition. Individualized treatment is provided in a highly supervised and structured environment. Residents who have been diagnosed with a severe clinical disorder and with major deficits in family, social, and educational adjustments, which cannot be served in less restrictive environments, can receive treatment at Barboursville School. Those who have been identified through assessment and referral as Barboursville School being able to meet their clinical needs will need an MCM1 and court order prior to admission.
