Psychiatric Residential Treatment

Adolescent Sex Offender Program (Roundtable) is a 21-bed residential treatment program for adolescent sexual offenders, designed for males 12 to 18 years of age. Some youth may stay beyond their 18th birthday under specific circumstances. The program is designed to work with adolescent males who have sexually acted out on others with a length of stay for the program at approximately 12 to 18 months. The youth often fall in the moderate to high risk range for sexually acting out and have failed less restrictive attempts of treatment. The program offers a 12 step Relapse Prevention Model as well as providing a way to address their own trauma in a safe environment. The program also teaches way to control arousal and urges to act out sexually. The program does use the Polygraph to work towards honesty of sexual offenses. The youth do not have to be adjudicated prior to referral or admission. The youth may be in the custody of the state of WV DHHR or their parents. The youth have an IQ above 70. A risk assessment needs to accompany the referral. Once the youth is accepted, an MCM1 is required prior to admission and a court order if the child is in the state's custody.

Diagnoses that would meet criteria include: Encounter for mental health services for perpetrator of nonparental child sexual abuse; in addition to other paraphilic disorders and mental health disorders.
