Youth with Intellectual Disabilities-

Dual Diagnosis Center- Individuals appropriate for this program are between the ages of 5 and 17, and have been diagnosed with an intellectual/developmental disability and mental health diagnosis. The Dual Diagnosis Center Programs offer two units to serve individuals between the ages of 5 and 17 who have a co-existence of symptoms of both mental retardation and mental illness. In addition to being identified with mental retardation, the candidates must also have been diagnosed with a psychiatric disturbance, as identified on Axis I. This program accepts children who display a wide range of challenging behaviors including aggression, property destruction, severe tantrum behavior, self-injurious behavior, run away problems, and the difficulty to follow directions reliably. The individuals admitted to the program display clear deficits in adaptive and social functioning. Treatment focuses on increasing independence in all settings using positive approaches.
