Males ages 10 to 18 years of age (up to age 21) with a history of problem sexual behaviors or other rule-breaking/conduct issues, including youth with a variety of trauma, psychiatric, or borderline intellectual functioning issues.

**Evidenced based practices**

The residential program utilizes a number of treatment approaches that have been found to be effective with both sexual offenders and non-sexual offenders. Two curricula are utilized and introduced to the youth based upon need and appropriateness: The *Pathways* guided treatment program from Safer Society and *Footprints* from the Safer Society. A cognitive-behavioral Relapse Prevention model of treatment is employed to focus on criminogenic and offender issues, within a multi-systemic approach that includes substance abuse education and counseling, art therapy, music therapy and recreation therapy. *Thinking for Change* is used as an evidenced-based CBT model used in our one behavioral multi-needs non-sex offender cottage.

Additional evidenced based practices that are used by staff include *Teaching Family Model*, *Collaborative Problem Solving (CPS)* and *Neurosequential Model of Therapeutics*. The culture of the campus is based in Trauma Informed Care.
