Males and Females ages 12 – 18 (must be placed day prior to 18th b-day) : Full scale IQ of 70 or above, DSM Axis I Diagnosis, Impulsive/Self-regulation difficulties, Inability to manage anger, Lack of Motivation, School Problems/Truancy, Exhibits Poor Coping Skills, Aggressive Behaviors, Low Self-Esteem, Victim of Abuse.

Anger Replacement Training (ART): ART is a research-based therapy that targets the following interventions:

Substance Abuse Treatment: Albion Prep is a licensed provider of Substance Abuse Treatment by the State of Michigan and uses The Seven Challenges evidence-based, SAMHSA-approved model of substance abuse treatment that helps students make thoughtful decisions about substance abuse and their lives.

Trauma Therapy: Key treatment staff are trained in Structured Sensory Interventions (SITCAP) through the National Institute for Trauma & Loss in Children (TLC) to help youth who have been subjected to traumatic life events.

Juvenile Sexual Offender (JSO) Treatment: The Sexual Offenders Program serves adolescent males 12 through 18 years of age who have demonstrated inappropriate and/or aggressive sexual behaviors. The typical length of treatment ranges from 12 to 15 months.

Abuse/Neglect Mental Health Behavior Stabilization Program for Boys - Strength-based, Positive Youth Development. Staff Secure: Staff supervision 24/7. Doors are not locked on egress. Students participate in structured community activities. Staff/Student Ratio: 1:3. Population: Males, ages 12-17 (admission prior to 18th birthday), abuse neglect. Program length varies by individual treatment needs.
